

## Sixth Grade Social Conduct Code Agreement

Dear Parents and Students,

Our goal for the sixth grade social is that the students have fun in a safe environment. Based on feedback from past chaperones, current teachers, and school administrators, we've put together a code of conduct for the sixth grade social Costume Ball 2017. The intention of this document is to avoid some of the destructive and dangerous behaviors that have occurred in the past. All students are expected to behave in accordance with the Curtis Middle School rules and dress should be in line with the Curtis dress code.

### **Below are some examples of behavior occurring at past sixth grade socials that will not be tolerated:**

- Destruction or tampering with any party favors; decorations; props
- Lights may not be removed, handled, or kicked
- Treat the rented games in the gym with respect. They must be returned in good condition

#### Misuse of Refreshments:

- No flipping of water cups/bottles
- Water is not to be intentionally spilled on the floor
- Water may not be brought into the bathrooms
- Chips and cookies are not to be thrown and trash must be put in the trash bins
- All food and drink must be consumed in the designated area

#### Costume Restrictions:

- No weapons, sharp, or dangerous props are to be brought into the school
- No covering of the entire face by masks
- Appropriate dress and appropriate costumes as stated in the ECMS handbook

#### Use of Electronics:

- In accordance with Curtis rules, there will be no use of cell phones, iPod touches, or gaming devices during the event
- Cell phones may be stored with bags and jackets in the designated area in the cafeteria. Students wishing to call parents may ask a chaperone and then step into the hall.
